

Standards Aligned Classroom (SAC) for Area 1-North National Board Certified Teachers*

(*Funded by the I-KAN NBPTS State Support Site Contract)

- SAC training provides educators with the resources needed to meet the rigorous standards set by the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 and creates meaningful learning targets based on the Illinois Learning Standards.
- The two day Level I training, one day coach training, and 13 hours of participation on a SAC team are prerequisites for any NBCT interested in becoming a SAC coach. Participants will learn methodologies using a curriculum modeled after the work of Richard Stiggins. The Standards - Aligned Classroom Initiative provides educators the opportunity to reclaim their role as the determiners of key learning targets and appropriate classroom assessments.
 - *Materials, continental breakfast, and lunch are included.*
 - *Sub reimbursement will be provided for all three training dates, a daily sub rate of up to \$90 per day*
 - *Dates and times for SAC team meetings will be determined during Level I Training.*
 - *There will be a \$300 stipend for each participant who completes all components of this training.*
