The Instructional Practice Inventory (IPI) provides observational data about the nature of teaching practices across the school. An observer systematically observes classes throughout the school, obtaining more than 100 observations of teaching practices during a typical school day. A profile of the practices is provided for the staff. The six categorizations of teaching practices are: active learning/active teaching, teacher-led conversation, teacher-led instruction, student seatwork/teacher engaged, student seatwork teacher disengaged, and total disengagement
