



Standards Aligned Classroom (SAC) for Area 4 National Board Certified Teachers

SAC training provides educators with the resources needed to meet the rigorous standards set by the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 and creates meaningful learning targets based on the Illinois Learning Standards.

The one day Level I training, one day coach training and 13 hours of participation in an online SAC team are prerequisites for any NBCT interested in becoming a SAC coach. Participants will learn methodologies using a curriculum modeled after the work of Richard Stiggins. The Standards-Aligned Classroom Initiative provides educators the opportunity to reclaim their role as the determiners of key learning targets and appropriate classroom assessments.

- *Materials, breakfast, and lunch are included.*
- *Sub reimbursement will be provided for the two training dates at the district's daily sub rate, up to \$90.*
- *Online SAC team requirements will be explained during the Level I Training. There will be a \$300 stipend for participation in the online SAC team component.*
