**Description:** Participants in the Level I workshop will be developing the capacity to accurately and consistently code student engaged learning. The development of that skill will begin in the workshop room. By early afternoon, the participants will be ready to apply their new knowledge in a real classroom setting. Participants from the workshop will be visiting the classrooms at Centralia City Schools District #135 in the early afternoon.

Small groups will visit the classrooms in small for just three or four minutes each for approximately an hour, thus trying to minimize the distractions to the learning process. The participants will be observing the student's engagement in learning and will not be evaluating the work of the teacher or even focusing on the work of the teacher during the observation.

Participants will achieve the following goals:

Develop the capacity to collect accurately school-wide instructional practices data using the IPI observational categories and to do so across observations and among observers.

Develop the capacity to facilitate faculty analysis of the school-wide data profiles and the deep reflective activities necessary for improving student engaged learning.
