The Instructional Practice Inventory (IPI) provides observational data about the nature of teaching practices across a school. An observer systematically observes classes throughout a school, obtaining more than 100 observations of teaching practices during a typical school day. A profile of the practices is provided for the staff. The six categorizations of teaching practices are: active learning/active teaching, teacher-led conversation, teacher-led instruction, student seatwork/teacher engaged, student seatwork teacher disengaged, and total disengagement.
